They meet in Cordoba, where they have a good time together and benefit from this event. This will be the first time that Indonesia has been represented and the competition for places will be tough.

Every year important people from all over the world come to the FIE to share with you their ideas, life experiences and the best pieces of advice for your career. There will be four lectures during the event about different topics like economics and leadership, but also social or moral issues. For the Workshops and Conferences the participants are divided into groups of 20 people which are assisted by two IMPULSORES. Interactive discussions and exchange of ideas help to integrate and to learn a lot about yourself. The IMPULSORES are important throughout the whole FIE. They support the participants, coordinate the activities and will help you in any situation.
