

PJI WORKS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR DAN TRANSMIGRATION TO PROVIDE ENTREPRENEURSHIP EDUCATION FOR YOUNG BUSINESS PEOPLE

In five locations across the Indonesian archipelago PJI is currently working with *Depnaker* to provide training for young entrepreneurs. This has been undertaken in Aceh, Bekasi, and Mojokerto with additional programs still to run in Mataram and Samarinda. The objectives of these initiatives include providing young people in each of the locations with specific knowledge about business operation, to motivate individuals to explore opportunities to grow their business, and to assist in an understanding of best practices. In each location PJI has been assisted by representatives from Depnaker and also local NGO's.
